I have been involved in theatre and drama based activities for over 30 years and thoroughly enjoy what I do. Essentially, I turned my hobby into a job! Children love theatre arts and all the benefits it brings with it; self expression, life skills, reading, writing and listening skills, presentation, public speaking and decision making skills. Not to mention how the power of drama and the spoken word gives enhanced empowering abilities that assist young people in many aspects of their day to day lives and education. And of course, its lots of fun! I see firsthand how, after warm ups or beginning activities, pupils are inspired to be creative and use their imagination. How working with different people within the group brings out many different ideas, builds confidence and finds new friends!

I have had some fantastic roles myself over the years and this is what inspired me to now do what I do. Some of my favourite roles were- ELIZA- My Fair Lady, ANNIE- Annie Get Your Gun, ALDONZA-Man of La Mancha, AUDREY-Little Shop of Horrors, MRS JOHNSTON-Blood Brothers and SISTER ROBERT ANNE- Nunsense among many others! I have performed with Bradford Youth Players, Ripon AODS, Guiseley Amateurs, Bradford Catholic Players and Idle & Thackley AODS at St Georges Hall, Harrogate Theatre, Guiseley Theatre, Alhambra Theatre, The Priestley, Alhambra Studio, Library Theatre and Idle & Thackley Little Theatre.

As well as performing I have previously directed, produced and delivered over 30 shows for Bradford Youth Players and my own theatre school. Some of my directing credits are; Alice the Musical, Buggy Malone, Guys & Dolls Jr, Honk!, Midsummer Night's Dream (Shakespeare4KIDZ), The Lion, the Witch & the Wardrobe, Cinderella(Panto), Bits & Bobs, Joseph and His Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, Christmas Crackers, The Peace Child, Hoodwinked, Christmas Box, Annie Jr, Shake, Ripple & Roll, High School Musical and Les Miserable –School Edition.

Classes at Applause involve script work, improvisation, mime, movement, dance, singing, script writing, drama games, confidence building exercises, presentation skills, voice skills and much more. Our aim is to ensure that young people have a great time while learning the tricks of the trade. All areas take part in an annual performance, which can be a full show or a bits and pieces type of affair. Each show is tailored to the individuals who take part. As well as scripted work, pupils are encouraged to devise their own pieces. Pieces start in class and by the time we get them on stage they are often completely different! They have gone through many stages of written word, discussion, improvisation and change of roles, role play, etc before they get to the finished product.

Students are actively encouraged to take part in what goes into each show, working constantly with staff to ensure that they are always part of the whole process, not just the performance. This gives pupils empowering abilities that will assist them in their day to day lives- confidence, decision making, public speaking and presentation skills.

Terms and Conditions

- 01.** Fees are calculated so that equal monthly amounts are payable, with the exception of August. The amount payable for the whole year will be divided by 11.
- 02.** REGISTRATION IS FREE. Should there not be a place, your child's name will be put on a waiting list until such a place is available. Fees are payable at the second class your child attends.
- 03.** Invoices are payable by the 1st of each month. Fees not received by the DUE DATE each month will be subject to a late penalty fee of £5. Please pay fees on time. Should fees become outstanding for two months or more, your child will be unable to attend their class.
- 04.** The school will be open for 38 weeks per year, term time only with the exception of a summer school each August.
- 05.** We prefer that pupils do not attend other theatre/dance schools while taking Applause classes. However, if this is the case, please let us know.
- 06.** Your place at the school is permanent. One month's notice of termination is required or fees paid in lieu.
- 07.** If your child is absent, payment of fees must still be made as your child's place is retained for them until notice of termination.
- 08.** Once your child has left the building, Applause cannot be held responsible for their safety. Please ask your child to remain in the building until they are picked up.
- 09.** The school cannot be held responsible for items left on the premises. Please ensure they are taken home.
- 10.** Pupils who are disruptive will be given a verbal warning by the principle. If the behaviour continues a written warning will be sent home to parents. Should the problem still persist the pupil will be asked to leave, forfeiting all fees.
- 11.** Applause reserves the right to remove any pupil from a class if they feel it is no longer beneficial to the child.
- 12.** Mobile phones must be switched off during class, unless a specific request has been made to keep it on. (Emergencies only)
- 13.** Chewing gum and eating in class is not permitted by the school. Drinks may be brought into class as long as they are brought in suitable containers (i.e. sports caps)
- 14.** Extra tuition and class fees may be payable when your child is involved in a show, examinations or festivals. Prior notice will be given. Parents will have the option to pay by instalments if necessary.
- 15.** Costume fees may be payable when your child is involved in a show. Parents will have the option to pay by instalments if necessary
- 16.** Applause T-shirts and sweatshirts are available. Please make sure your child wears suitable clothes and shoes for physical activity.
- 17.** Please encourage your child to not leave any rubbish behind and dispose of it in provided bins.
